In my 25 years of breeding, true winners are rare, but Dolcita was unmistakable, which is why it's now one of the quickest cross-to-market hops we've ever had."

"Dolcita is the boldest representation of the Hop Breeding Company's mission: to provide brewers with the best, most unique, and most sustainable hops on the planet," said Jeff Dailey, Sensory Manager at John I. Haas. "With aromas of caramelized pineapple, peach rings, and orange juice, consumers will think they're drinking a tropical daiquiri rather than an IPA.
